Bridgeport Gun Club Scholarship Protocol

Applications will be available beginning in January. There will be a reminder in the January and February newsletters. Copies of the application will be available on the Bridgeport Gun Club website, and at the club.

Applications will be due on or before the end of the March meeting. The scholarship committee will meet during March and give recommendations to the board at the April meeting. Five Thousand dollars (\$5000.00) will be given away annually with a minimum of five hundred (\$500.00) per winner.

A point system will be used to determine the top most qualified applicants and the amount given to each. Applications that are not turned in by the deadline or are not complete will not be considered. Each application must be accompanied by a copy of their latest transcripts and two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from the member who is a qualified relative and the other from an educator or a civic leader.

Qualified relative are the member or spouse, child, grandchild, brother, sister, niece or nephew of a member of the club.

Applicants also must have a grade point average of 2.0 or better.
